Subject: **NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF SUSPENSION OF CDS ELIGIBILITY OF MODARABA CERTIFICATES OF FIRST TRI-STAR MODARABA UNDER THE CDC REGULATIONS**

This is further to our notice no. CDC/CS/156/2014 dated October 09, 2014 notifying further extension of suspension of CDS Eligibility of Modaraba Certificates (Security Symbol: FTSM) of First Tri-Star Modaraba (hereinafter referred to as the "Issuer") for 60 Business-Days commencing from October 10, 2014 on account of failure by the Issuer to:

- Settle the CDC invoices in accordance with the Fees & Deposits Schedule in discharge of its obligation under the CDC Regulations;
- Complete the formalities with regards to appointment of independent Registrar / Transfer Agent under the CDC Regulations; and
- Submit the Registrar / Transfer Agent Reconciliation reports.

Considering that the Issuer is continuously in default of aforesaid regulatory requirements, Central Depository Company of Pakistan Limited has decided that the CDS Eligibility of Modaraba Certificates of the Issuer shall remain suspended for a further period of 60 Business Days commencing from January 07, 2015.

Restoration of CDS Eligibility of Modaraba Certificates of the Issuer shall be subject to removal of causes of suspension in every respect.
